<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: Why did Moses plead with God to not have to speak to the people?</p> <p>Answer: He didn't think he was a good public speaker (slow of speech, slow of tongue).</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Exodus 4:10)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: Who did God say He would use to be Moses' public speaker?</p> <p>Answer: Aaron, the brother of Moses</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Exodus 4:14-16)</p>

What did Aaron's rod do to the rods of the magicians?</p> <p>Answer: Aaron's rod swallowed the rods of the magicians.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Exodus 7:12)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: In the first plague, what did Aaron do with his rod to the river water in Egypt?</p> <p>Answer: He struck the water and it turned to blood.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Exodus 7:20)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: In the second plague, what did Aaron do with his rod regarding frogs?</p> <p>Answer: He stretched it over the waters and caused frogs to come out onto the land to plague the land.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Exodus 8:6)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: In the third plague, when Aaron struck his rod on the dust of the ground, what happened?</p> <p>Answer: The dust of the ground turned to lice throughout the land, on both man and beast.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Exodus 8:17)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: In the fourth plague, God sent swarms of what to plague the land of Egypt, except for Goshen where the Israelites dwelt?</p> <p>Answer: Flies</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Exodus 8:21)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: In the fifth plague, what did God send to the livestock of the Egyptians, but not of the Israelites?</p> <p>Answer: Severe pestilence, or disease</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Exodus 9:3, 4)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: In the sixth plague, when Moses and Aaron threw handfuls of ashes from a furnace in the air, and the ashes turned to fine dust throughout Egypt, what did the fine dust do?</p> <p>Answer: It caused boils to break out in sores on man and beast throughout Egypt.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Exodus 9:9)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: In the seventh plague, God rained down what on all of Egypt, except for Goshen where the Israelites dwelt?</p> <p>Answer: Hail mixed with fire</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Exodus 9:23-26)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: In the eighth plague, what plague did God send that caused the land to darken, and every herb and fruit that was left from the hailstorm to be eaten, so nothing green was left on the trees or plants in the land of Egypt?</p> <p>Answer: Locusts</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Exodus 10:13-15)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: In the ninth plague, what happened to the land of Egypt for three days, except for the dwelling places of the Israelites?</p> <p>Answer: It was covered with thick darkness, so thick you could feel it.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">(Exodus 10:21-23)</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: What event in the history of Israel does Passover represent?</p> <p>Answer: It represents when God struck the 10th plague on Egypt, the death of the firstborn; and death passed over the dwellings of the Israelites who put the blood of the sacrificed, unblemished, male, 1-year old lamb on the two doorposts and lintel. (Exodus 12; 12:13)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: What is the name of the Israelite feast that was commanded by God, where for seven days the Israelites eat unleavened bread, and on the seventh day they have a feast to the Lord?</p> <p>Answer: Feast of Unleavened Bread (Exodus 12:17)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: What does the last day of the special feast with unleavened bread commemorate?</p> <p>Answer: It commemorates the day God, with His strong hand, brought the armies of Israel out of the land of Egypt. (Exodus 12:17; 13:8, 9)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: What was the tenth and final plague that God struck on Egypt?</p> <p>Answer: Death of all the firstborn (except for Israelites who marked their doors with blood of lamb) (Exodus 12:29)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: About how many Israelite men left Egypt during the exodus?</p> <p>Answer: about 600,000 (Exodus 12:37)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: How many years had passed from the time Jacob's family had moved to Egypt during the great famine to the time of the exodus?</p> <p>Answer: 430 years (Exodus 12:40)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: When God called for the Israelites to set apart their firstborn (sacrifice the firstborn animals, redeem the firstborn children), what event in the history of the Israelites was being commemorated?</p> <p>Answer: When God struck the firstborn of the Egyptians with the plague of death, but He delivered the Israelites by His strong hand (Exodus 13:14-15)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: When God took the Israelites out of Egypt and led them by way of the wilderness of the Red Sea, in what special way did God lead them by day and give them light by night?</p> <p>Answer: He was in a pillar of cloud by day and in a pillar of fire by night. (Exodus 13:21)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: By what miracle did God bring the Israelites from one side of the Red Sea to the other side?</p> <p>Answer: He parted the Red Sea into two walls and had the Israelites pass over from one side to the other on dry ground. (Exodus 14:21-22, 29)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bible Detective</p> <p>Question: By what miracle did God bring the end of the Egyptian pursuit of the Israelites after the Israelites passed to the other side of the Red Sea?</p> <p>Answer: He had the sea return to its full depth, which brought the death of all the Egyptians who had been in pursuit of the Israelites. (Exodus 14:26-30)</p>
