

Leviticus Inductive Study Symbols Key Chart

The following codes are based on the Holman Christian Standard Bible (HCSB). Use comparable words for your Bible version. To print out chapter pages for marking symbols, go to <http://www.biblegateway.com/> . Under Quick Search, type in the book name and chapter number, then change the version to Holman Christian Standard Bible (or whatever version you prefer).

Give each child a printed copy of the Bible chapter, a copy of this symbols key chart, and colored pencils. Be sure the child reads the entire chapter BEFORE marking words. In our family, one of us reads the chapter out loud to the group.

You will note that next to each symbol and its applicable word(s), there appear numbers inside of parentheses and brackets. To be more child-friendly, I have designed this inductive study to more like a word search puzzle. The numbers inside the parentheses represent the verse numbers where the designated words appear, while the numbers in brackets inside the parentheses represent the number of times the word appears in that verse. For example, say that you see (3[1]). This means that the designated word appears in verse 3, and it only appears once.

Chapter 1 ~ Burnt Offering

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

purple rectangle = offering, burnt offering, burn, burnt, burning, fire offering, fire (v. 2[2]; 3[1]; 4[1]; 6[1]; 7[2]; 8[1]; 9[3]; 10[1]; 12[1]; 13[3]; 14[2]; 15[1]; 17[4])

red cross = blood (v. 5[1]; 11[1]; 15[1])

brown circle = unblemished male (v. 3[1]; 10[1])

blue triangle = atonement (v. 4[1])

black underline = "all of it" (v. 9[1]; 13[1])

Chapter 2 ~ Grain Offering

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

purple rectangle = grain offering, fire offering, offering(s), offered (v. 1[1]; 2[1]; 3[2]; 4[1]; 5[1]; 6[1]; 7[1]; 8[1]; 9[2]; 10[2]; 11[2]; 12[2]; 13[3]; 14[2]; 15[1]; 16[1])

brown underline = fine flour, firstfruits, fresh heads (v. 1[1]; 2[1]; 4[1]; 5[1]; 7[1]; 12[1]; 14[3])

green circle = olive oil, oil (v. 1[1]; 2[1]; 4[2]; 5[1]; 6[1]; 7[1]; 15[1]; 16[1])

blue rectangle = frankincense (v. 1[1]; 2[1]; 15[1]; 16[1])

gray X = unleavened, no...yeast, not...yeast (v. 4[1]; 5[1]; 11[2])

tan triangle = not...honey (v. 11[1])

orange diamond = salt, salt of the covenant (v. 13[3])

black zigzag = break it into pieces, crushed (v. 6[1]; 14 [1]; 16[1])

Chapter 3 ~ Peace Offering

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

purple rectangle = offering, fellowship sacrifice, fire offering, burnt offering (v. 1[2]; 2[1]; 3[2]; 5[2]; 6[2]; 7[1]; 8[1]; 9[2]; 11[1]; 12[1]; 14[2]; 16[1])

brown circle = without blemish (v. 1[1]; 6[1])

red cross = blood (v. 2[1]; 8[1]; 13[1]; 17[1])

gray triangle = fat, fatty (v. 3[2]; 4[2]; 9[4]; 10[2]; 14[2]; 15[2]; 16[1]; 17[1])

green underline = food (v. 11[1]; 16[1])

Chapter 4 ~ Sin Offering:

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

purple rectangle = sin offering, burnt offering, offering, fire offerings (v. 3[1]; 7[1]; 8[1]; 10[1]; 14[1]; 18[1]; 20[1]; 21[1]; 23[1]; 24[2]; 25[3]; 28[1]; 29[2]; 30[1]; 32[2]; 33[3]; 34[2]; 35[1])

brown circle = unblemished (v. 3[1]; 23[1]; 28[1]; 32[1])

red cross = blood (v. 5[1]; 6[1]; 7[2]; 16[1]; 17[1]; 18[2]; 25[2]; 30[2]; 34[2])

black slash = sin(s), prohibited, guilt, errs, violate(s) (v. 2[2]; 3[4]; 13[4]; 14[2]; 20[1]; 21[1]; 22[4]; 23[1]; 24[1]; 25[1]; 26[1]; 27[4]; 28[2]; 29[1]; 32[1]; 32[1]; 33[2]; 34[1]; 35[1])

orange squiggle underline = unintentionally, escapes the notice (v. 2[1]; 13[1]; 22[1]; 27[1])

blue underline = lay his hand on (v. 4[1]; 15[1]; 24[1]; 29[1]; 33[1])

blue triangle = atonement, forgiven (v. 20[2]; 26[2]; 31[2]; 35[2])

Chapter 5 ~ Restitution Offering:

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

purple rectangle = restitution (v. 6 [1], 7 [1], 16 [1]);

restitution offering (v. 15 [2], 16 [1], 18 [1], 19 [1])

black slash = sins, guilty, unclean, uncleanness, defiled, guilt, sinning, error (v. 1-5 [find 9 out of 18]; v. 7-13 [find 5 out of 10]; v. 14-19 [find 3 out of 6])

orange circle = confess (v. 5 [1])

blue triangle = atonement, forgiven (v.6 [1], 10 [2], 13 [2], 16 [2], 18 [2])

red cross = blood (v. 9 [2])

orange squiggle underline = without being aware of it, unintentionally, without knowing (v. 2 [1], 3 [1], 4 [1], 14 [1], 17 [1], 18 [1])

Chapter 8 ~ Ordination Offering:

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

purple rectangle = ordination, ordination offering, presentation offering, ordain (v. 22 [1]; 27 [1]; 28 [1]; 29 [2]; 31 [1]; 33 [2])

blue triangle = atonement (15 [1]; 34 [1])

purple squiggle underline = anointing, anointed (2 [1]; 10 [2]; 11 [1]; 12 [2]; 30 [1])

pink underline = consecrate; consecrated (10 [1]; 11 [1]; 12 [1]; 15 [1]; 30 [1])

green rectangle = "Aaron (and) his sons", Aaron, Aaron's, Aaron's sons, his sons (2 [1]; 6 [1]; 7 [1]; 12 [1]; 13 [1]; 14 [1]; 18 [1]; 22 [1]; 23 [1]; 24 [1]; 27 [1]; 30 [4]; 31 [2]; 36 [1])

Chapter 10 ~ Nadab and Abihu

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

yellow circle = Aaron's sons Nadab and Abihu (v. 1[1])

blash slash = unauthorized, not commanded (v. 1[2])

red underline = all of verse 2 ("Then flames leaped from the LORD's presence and burned them to death before the LORD.")

brown rectangle = holiness, glory, holy (v. 3[2]; 10[1]; 12[1]; 13[1]; 17[1])

Chapter 11 ~ Clean and Unclean Food

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

pink half-circle (bottom half, like a smile) = may eat, may be eaten, clean (v. 2[1]; 3[1]; 9[2]; 21[1]; 22[1]; 32[1]; 36[1]; 37[1]; 47[2])

black slash = not to eat, unclean, do not eat, detestable, must not eat, must detest, detest, must not be eaten, contaminated, defiled, may not be eaten (v. 4[2]; 5[1]; 6[1]; 7[1]; 8[2]; 10[1]; 11[3]; 12[1]; 13[3]; 20[1]; 23[1]; 24[2]; 25[1]; 26[2]; 27[2]; 28[2]; 29[1]; 31[2]; 32[2]; 33[1]; 34[3]; 35[3]; 36[1]; 38[1]; 39[1]; 40[2]; 41[2]; 42[2]; 43[3]; 44[1]; 47[2])

brown rectangle = be holy because I am holy (v. 44[1]; 45[1])

Chapter 13 ~ Laws Concerning Skin Diseases and Diseased Garments

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

green rectangle = Aaron; Aaron the priest; one of his sons, the priests; priest (v. 1[1]; 2[2]; 3[2]; 4[1]; 5[2]; 6[2]; 7[2]; 8[2]; 9[1]; 10[1]; 11[1]; 12[1]; 13[1]; 15[1]; 16[1]; 17[2]; 19[1]; 20[2]; 21[2]; 22[1]; 23[1]; 25[2]; 26[2]; 27[2]; 28[1]; 30[2]; 31[2]; 32[1]; 33[1]; 34[2]; 36[2]; 37[1]; 39[1]; 43[1]; 44[1]; 49[1]; 50[1]; 51[1]; 53[1]; 54[1]; 55[1]; 56[1])

pink triangle = examine(s), pronounce, reexamine, examination, order, look (v. 3[3]; 5[1]; 6[2]; 8[2]; 10[1]; 11[1]; 13[2]; 15[2]; 17[2]; 20[2]; 21[1]; 22[1]; 23[1]; 25[2]; 26[1]; 27[2]; 28[1]; 30[2]; 31[1]; 32[1]; 34[2]; 36[1]; 37[1]; 39[1]; 43[1]; 44[1]; 50[1]; 51[1]; 53[1]; 54[1]; 55[1]; 56[1])

upside-down black triangle = quarantine, live alone in a place outside the camp (v. 4[1]; 5[1]; 11[1]; 21[1]; 26[1]; 31[1]; 33[1]; 46[1]; 50[1]; 54[1])

Chapter 16 ~ Day of Atonement

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

gray circle = two male goats for a sin offering (v. 5[1]); two goats (7[1], 8[1]); goat...sacrifice it as a sin offering (9[1]); goat...presented alive...to make purification with it by sending it into the wilderness (10[1]); male goat for the people's sin offering (15[1]); goat's (18[1]); live male goat (20[1]); live goat (21[1]); goat's head and send [it] away into the wilderness (21[1]); goat will carry on it all their wrongdoings into a desolate land, and he will release it there (22[1]); goat (26[1]); goat for the sin offering (27[1])

red cross = blood (v. 14[2]; 15[3]; 18[2]; 19[1]; 27[1])

blue triangle = atonement (v. 6[1]; 11[1]; 17[2]; 18[1]; 24[1]; 27[1]; 30[1]; 32[1]; 33[1]; 34[1])

purple underline = all of verse 4

Chapter 17 ~ Laws Concerning Where to Bring Offerings and Concerning Eating/Drinking Blood

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

black squiggle underline = all of verses 7 & 8 and all of verses 11 & 12

Chapter 19 ~ Laws of Holiness

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

brown rectangle = Be holy because I, the LORD your God, am holy; I am the LORD your God; holy to the LORD; I am the LORD; you are to fear your God; Fear your God (v. 2[1]; 3[1]; 4[1]; 8[1]; 10[1]; 12[1]; 14[2]; 16[1]; 18[1]; 25[1]; 28[1]; 30[1]; 31[1]; 32[2]; 34[1]; plus verse 36 beginning with "I am the LORD your God....." through to the end of verse 37)

Chapter 21 ~ Holiness of Priests

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

brown rectangle = holy (v. 6[2]; 7[1]; 8[3])

brown circle = around all of verses 16 through 24

Chapter 22 ~ Acceptable Offerings

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

purple circle = "[For] I am the LORD who sets them apart"; "I am the LORD who sets you apart" (v. 9[1]; 15[1]; 32[1])

brown circle = unblemished male; not...defect; no defect (v. 19[1]; 20[1]; 21[2])

brown rectangle = "deal respectfully with the holy offerings"; "do not profane My holy name"; "They must keep My instruction"; "The priests must not profane the holy offerings"; "You are to keep My commands and do them"; "You must not profane My holy name; I must be treated as holy" (v. 2[2]; 9[1]; 15[1]; 31[1]; 32[1])

Chapter 25 ~ Sabbath Years and Year of Jubilee

Symbols and Words/Word Phrases:

purple squiggle underline = Sabbath, Sabbath of complete rest for the land in the seventh year, Sabbath year (v. 2[1]; 4[2]; 6[1])

yellow rectangle = fiftieth year, Jubilee, Year of Jubilee (v. 10[2]; 11[2]; 12[1]; 13[1]; 15[1]; 28[2]; 30[1]; 31[1]; 33[1]; 40[1]; 50[1]; 52[1]; 54[1])
